II. THE GOAL, LEARNING OUTCOMES AND DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT COURSE	
GOAL OF SUBJECT COURSE	To enable students gain (a better) insight into labor market institution and functions alongside and in conjunction with the optimization (right sizing) of production processes. Being run in the workshop format, the students learn to implement the theoretical aspects studied into solving certain, practical case studies in order to get some hands-on experience.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	By the end of this course, the students will have acquired: 1. A clarified perception of correlations between labor (market) and capital, viewed from the perspective of corporate cost structure, with the aim of finding feasible opportunities for their optimization; 2. Essential knowledge needed to assess the labor market situation, in conformity with the different phases of the economic cycle; 3. Obtained an overview of types of unemployment, and of labor market policies.
