Erasmus+ Activities (Key action 1: Learning Mobility of Individuals)

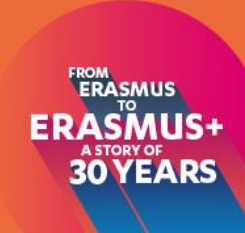
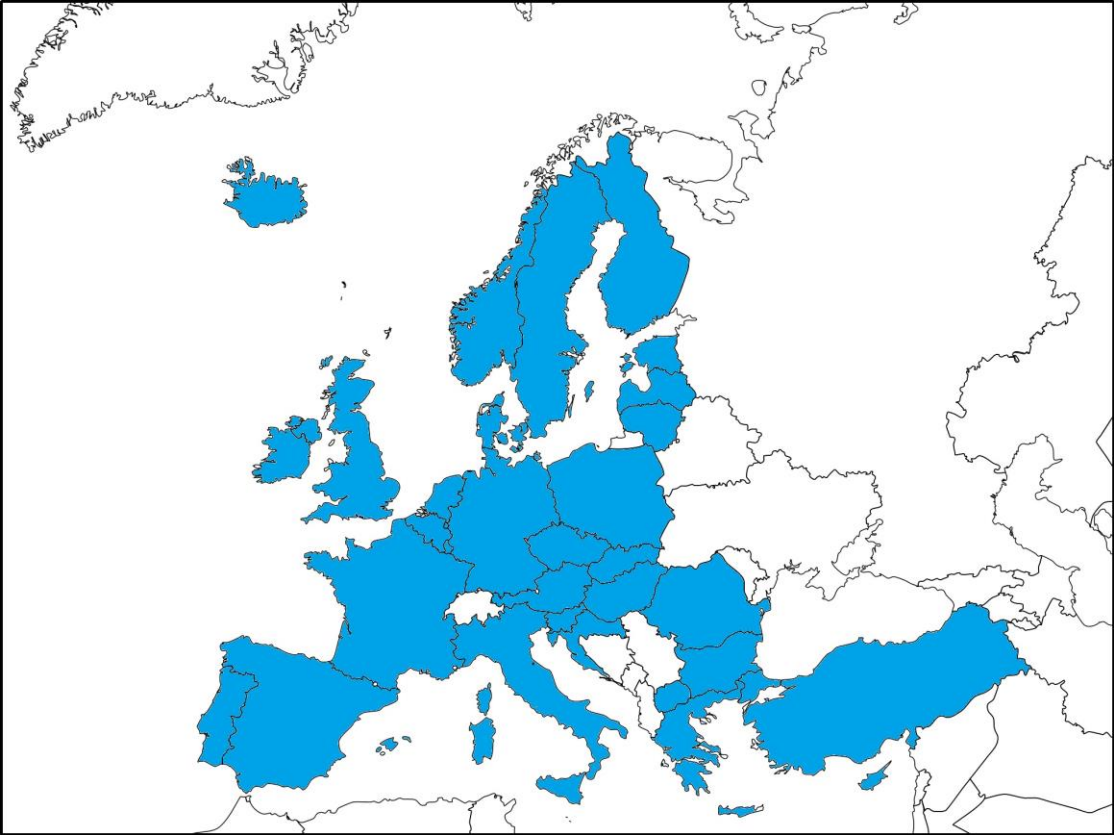
Student mobility:

- ✓ Study periods abroad at a partner higher education institution (HEI) for 3-12 months;
- ✓ Traineeships abroad for 2-12 months;
- ✓ Recent graduate traineeships for 2-12 months

Staff mobility:

- ✓ Teaching periods for 2 days to 2 months
- ✓ Training periods for 2 days to 2 months
- ✓ Invited experts from abroad

Erasmus+ Programme Countries

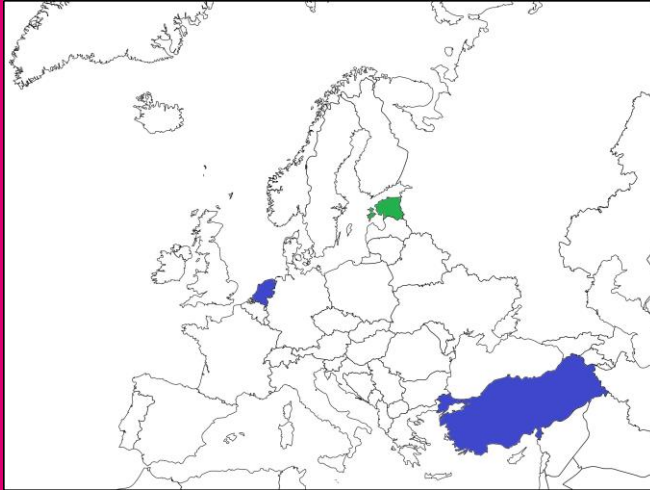


From Erasmus LLP to Erasmus+

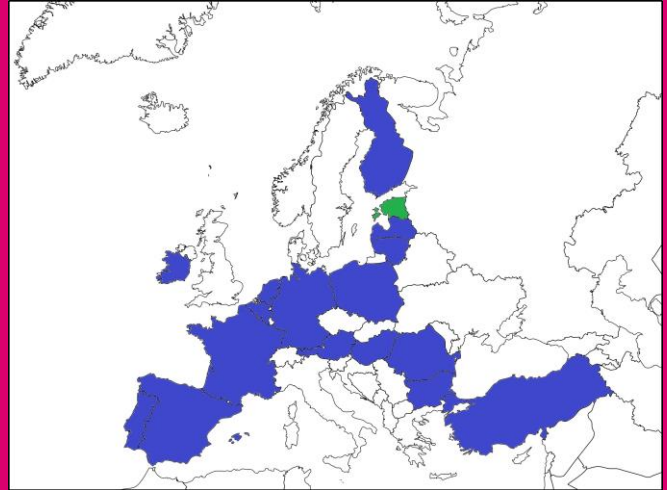
- ✓ 2007: EAVA becomes Erasmus LLP member

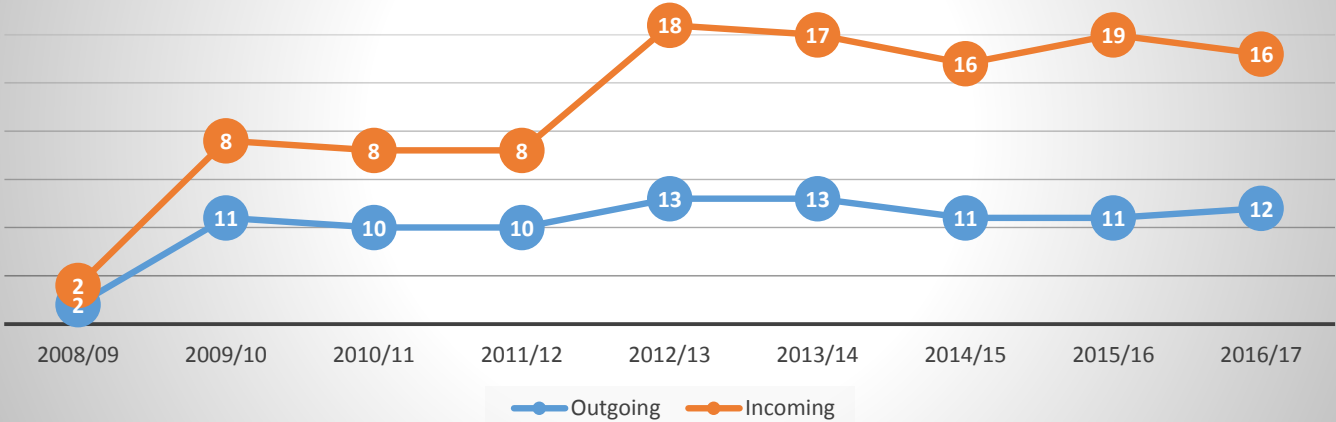

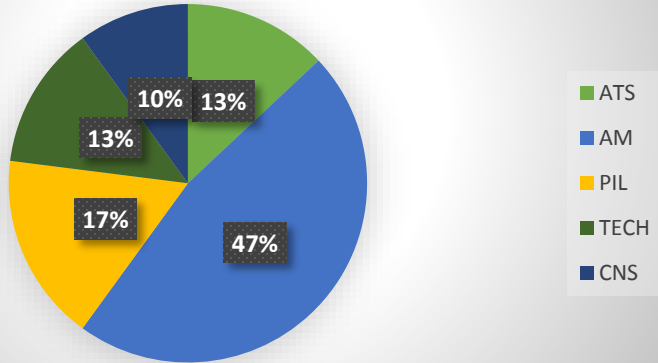
Erasmus at EAVA in Numbers

Erasmus student exchanges at EAVA in 2008/09 - 2016/17

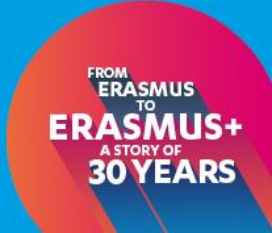
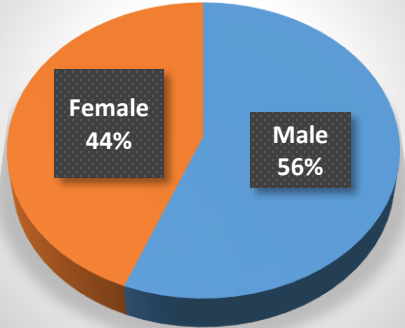

Student exchanges according to speciality

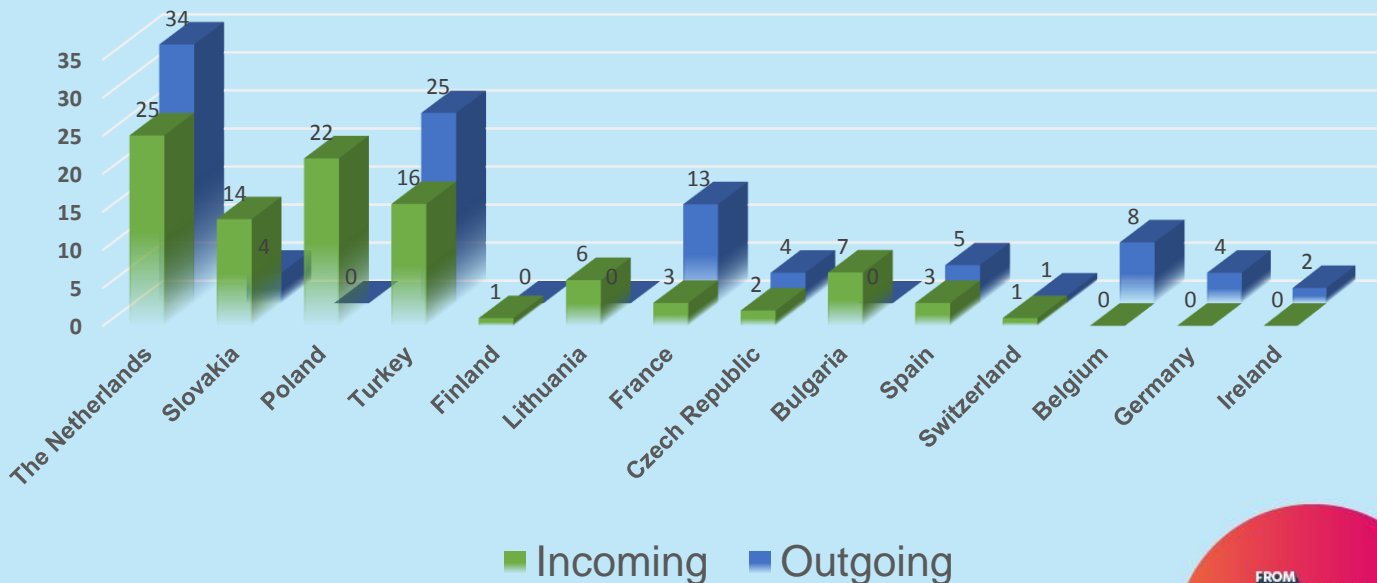


Female Vs Male
