Plans are underway for the second joint congress of dance and the Child international (daCi) and World Dance Alliance (WDA) Global Education and Training Network to be held in Adelaide Australia.

Panpapanpalya 2018 will be one of the world's largest gatherings of dancers, dance educators, and artists of all ages, generating new thoughts and ideas for dance learning and teaching in the 21st century. The congress is centered on four interwoven themes: **dance**, **gathering**, **generations**, **learning**, summarised by the Aboriginal Kurna word Panpapanpalya, honouring Australia's rich Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander dance practices, as well as indigenous dance cultures from around the world.

Babies, young children, school and university students, dance artists, community and cultural workers, parents and carers, as well as educators, will be involved as participants and presenters coming from all over the world.

We invite proposals for our **Twinning Projects** that address the Panpapanpalya 2018 core themes and sub themes. Twinning is an opportunity for people from diverse cultural backgrounds and places to share skills and knowledge in a collaborative process to create new understandings. The shared focus could be a cultural perspective on a global issue, a concept to be explored, a story, poem or piece of music as stimulus or a choreographic exchange. Closing date: 1 September 2017

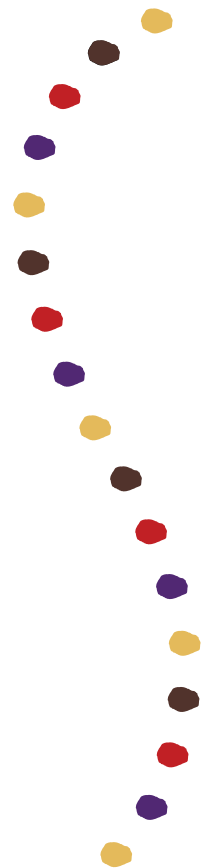
