Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be :

- Continuing to share and play co-operatively.
- Talking about how we might find some things difficult.
- Following the Golden Rules- Do be gentle, Do be kind and helpful, Do listen, Do look after property, Do be honest, Do work hard.
- Learning about the importance of basic hygiene eg washing hands before lunch etc.
- Practising our listening skills
- Thinking about how it feels to win and lose.
- Sharing our thoughts and ideas in group sessions.
- Thinking of ways to be helpful.
- Thinking about how to be a good friend.
- Starting to work with a talking partner.
- Thinking about ways to resolve conflict.

Physical Development

We will be:

- Practising dressing and undressing independently for PE.
- Practising fine motor skills and a correct pencil grip.
- Continuing to learn how to form all out letters and numbers correctly- including capitals.
- Developing more control in climbing and travelling through and around equipment.
- Understanding the importance of moving into a space and being aware of others.
- Learning how to use simple tools correctly and safely eg scissors.
- Playing simple outside games.
- Practising skills for Sports Day..
- Thinking about healthy eating.











Mathematical Development

Communication, Language and Literacy

We will be:

- Continuing to recognise and order numbers 20.
- Counting beyond 20.
- Practising counting accurately.
- Counting out amounts and matching to the correct numeral. Identifying missing numbers.
- Learning to keep a tally.
- Estimating amounts.
- Measuring and comparing objects by weight.
- Revisiting the naming and recognition of 3D shapes.
- Continuing to use addition/subtraction- writing our own number sentences.
- Recognising coins, using 1p's to buy items.
- Exploring sharing objects and doubling amounts.
- Creating and continuing own patterns.
- Weighing and comparing shells.



We will be:

- Beginning to learn phase 4 words using adjacent consonants eg tr st sp gl fl
- Increasing their sight vocabulary.
- Continuing to use 'robot voices' to sound out cvc words for reading and writing.
- Begin to read and write cvcc words eg bend tent etc.
- Listening and responding to stories linked to the topic.
- Using puppets to act out stories.
- Writing for different purposes including lists, speech bubbles, letters, invitations, recipes, non fiction writing, descriptions, instructions.
- Speaking and listening to each other in a range of situations.
- Sharing stories linked to the topic.
- Learning new words linked to the topic.
- Role play at the beach and the travel agents.

- Making models of sea creatures.
- Making lighthouses.
- Designing own rockpool.

- Tile printing of a sea scene.
