



Burning Records

Rules

1. Burning Records 2018 is a new event in the Tartu Student Days, of which the final competition is held on the 29th of September 2018 at 22:00 at Arhiiv.
2. At Burning Records you can use all concerted instruments and audio technics in addition to the ones at the venue.
3. At the competition the aspects being judged are technical skills, originality, the wholeness of the performance, performance skills and contact with the crowd.
4. To participate a form has to be filled found on the Tartu Student Days' homepage (www.studentdays.ee) under the event and submit it along with a demomix by sending it to the e-mail address osalen@studentdays.ee or by mail Ülikooli Kultuuriklubi, Kalevi 24, 51010 Tartu.
5. The deadline for registering and sending demos is the 15th of September 2018 (including the date provided).
6. The demomix can also be sent as a link, but by doing so you have to note which mix is participating in the competition. The demo does not have to be recorded in a studio – it simply has to have good enough quality to be listened to.
7. The maximum length for one demo that we will listen to is 15 minutes even if the sent demo is longer than required.
8. Four DJs are selected to perform at the event who are selected by a panel. The ones selected to do so will be contacted and their names will be published on the Tartu Student Days' homepage (www.studentdays.ee) no later than on the 17th of September 2018.
9. At the event each DJ is given exactly 40 minutes to perform. All genres are permitted and so are original songs.

10. The finalists will be judged by a jury comprised of specialists in their field.
11. The best DJ will be rewarded with the title of Best Record Burner 2018. In addition multiple special prizes will be given out.
12. The organizers of Burning Records reserve the right to make changes regarding the organization of the event, notifying the participants before the start of the event.
