Reglement

Flunkyball

- 1. Flunkyball is basically a beer drinking competition, which requires accuracy and speed. The competition is held between two teams and every team consists of four members. The event takes place at the 28th of April at 18.00 on the training ground of University of Tartu's sports hall.
- 2. You can only participate if you pre-register your team, because only 24 teams (96 people) can participate in this event. If some team does not want to participate or fails to come to the event, some additional teams can participate. The registration starts at the 10th of April at 18.00.
- 3. You must be at least 18 years old to participate.
- 4. During one game, two teams (4 people in a team) will compete with each other. The game takes place at four competing areas at the same time. Every participant has one beer. A half-full plastic bottle will be put on the center line equally from both teams. The task for both teams is to throw the bottle over with a tennis ball. Throwing takes place alternately and players inside a team must also take turns when throwing the ball. When a team throws the plastic bottle over, they have the right to drink their beers. The other team must run to put the plastic bottle up again and bring back the ball which was thrown. In addition, every member of the team must run to the center line and then back to their place. When they get back to their place, they must shout "Stop". After they have shouted "Stop", the other team must stop drinking and put their beer back to its initial place. The team who drinks their beers the fastest will be the winner. To make sure that all the bottles are empty, a judge takes a shot glass (2 cl) and fills it with what's remained in the bottles. When the shot glass will be full, the team whose beer filled the glass gets a penalty-beer. When a team makes other kinds of mistakes, they also get a penalty-beer. Other mistakes include: when a team member's leg is over the start line, when team starts running too early, when a team drinks their beer after "Stop" has been shouted or when a beer can falls over. A team who receives a penalty-beer can decide who from their members must drink the beer.
- 5. The organisers of Flunkyball reserve the right to make changes in the competition rules. All participants will be notified of the changes before the start of the competition.
