

## Pub Crawl Rules

- 1. Pub Crawl takes place on Thursday, April 27, 2017.
- 2. Registration begins on Monday, April 17 on Tartu Student Days festival website www.studentdays.ee. The participation fee is 9€ per team.
- 3. All contestants must be over 18 years of age and shouldn't be visibly intoxicated. Contestants aren't allowed to use any aids in solving tasks (e.g. smart phones).
- 4. All of the pubs/checkpoints must me completed in an order given by the officials. There are officials in every checkpoint who explain the tasks and give a signature to your team after successfully completing the task. While crossing the road, teams must follow the traffic regulations and must wait for the green light. Ignoring this rule will result in point reduction. Teams must consist of three members and must be represented by both genders, meaning there must be at least one female and one male in your team. The official finish time will be that of the last person in the team to arrive at the penultimate checkpoint Raekoja plats. The last checkpoint for every team is located in the Rock'n Roll club at Tiigi 76a and also the award ceremony takes place there.
- 5. The organisers of Pub Crawl reserve the right to change the competition rules. If this happens, all participants will be notified before the start of the competition.
