

Pub Crawl

Rules

- 1. Pub Crawl takes place on Friday, on the 4th of May at 6 PM in the Old Town of Tartu. The start will be given at Town Hall Square.
- Registration begins on the 16th of April on Tartu Student Days website
 www.studentdays.ee
 The participation fee for students is 9 € per team (3 people), 12
 € for anyone who is not a student.
- 3. Teams must consist of three members and must be represented by both genders, meaning there must be at least one female and one male in your team. All contestants must be over 18 years of age and should not be visibly intoxicated.
- 4. Competition rules and description:
 - Contestants are not allowed to use any aid in solving tasks (e.g. smart phones).
 - All the pubs/checkpoints must be completed in the order given by the officials. There are officials in every checkpoint who explain the tasks and give a signature to your team after completing the task.
 - While crossing the road, teams must follow the traffic regulations and must wait for the green light. Ignoring this rule will result in point reduction.

- The official finish time will be that of the last person in the team to arrive at the finish at Town Hall Square. It's also where the award ceremony will take place afterwards.
- The winner will be selected based on the points collected during solving the tasks and the time in which the track was completed.
- By registering, participants confirm that they have read and agreed to all the competition rules.
- 5. The organizers of Pub Crawl reserve the right to make changes in the competition.

 All participants will be notified of the changes before the start of the competition.
