Short presentation of your organisation (key activities, experience)	The Municipality of Lesichovo is located in the North-West part of the District of Pazardzhik. The Municipality is an administrative centre for seven villages: Lesichovo, Kalugerovo, Tserovo, Borimechkovo, Dinkaya, Pamidovo, and Shtarkovo, with a total population of around 5 600 people.  The Municipality of Lesichovo is particularly rich in cultural and historic heritage. This area has centuries-old traditions in agriculture, and wine production. It has well-developed social policy – centres for housing children in family-type environment, home for adults with disabilities, communal support centre. The Municipality works on several projects of communal aid, such as supplying warm food to people in disadvantaged circumstances, providing 'personal assistant' and 'home assistant' services to aging people and people who are incapable of being self-sufficient.  The Municipality's economic development is defined by companies representing manly the small and medium businesses. The majority belongs to commercial companies working with the production of luxury cardboard packaging, pharmaceuticals, production of plum preserve, fitting of car batteries, furniture and carpentry services,
