

## Dosing and application

Equanimity® is available in a single 5 ml gel dose which is very easy to administer.



Shake the stick 30 to 40 seconds prior to opening. Apply the content on the fingers.



The application must be equally distributed between the two nostrils.



The product should be administered 20/30 minutes prior to stressing the horse.

The efficacy lasts 2 hours.


The product can be reapplied over and over with no risk for the horse health.

## Why to use Equanimity®?

Equanimity® **is recommended for young horses, for all horses exposed to a new situation or exercise**, and for those that are nervous, highly-sensitive to any new feature in their environment (stallion, mare, gelding, foal, pony and mule).

Equanimity® **can be administered to pregnant mares**.

Compared to the existing calming aids, Equanimity® is different thanks to its **proven efficacy in controlling stress**, without inducing long-term side effects and without affecting the horse performance.

With Equanimity® properly used you deliver the right dose at the right time.

All the components of Equanimity® are found in the horse living tissues.

Equanimity® works on the horse brain thanks to the neurons linking the vomeronasal organ to the olfactory bulb. The product cannot be found in any internal fluids (blood, lymph, cerebrospinal fluid or urine).

None of Equanimity® components are to be found on the Federation Equestre Internationale's list of prohibited substances (FEI).

Equanimity® **is not a doping substance** and can be used during races and competitions.

Equanimity® does not cause drowsiness and the "heavy legs syndrome".

Equanimity® does not generate any short term and long term side effect.
