



# ECO STONE<sup>™</sup> Instructions for use

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#### **PREPERATION**

All sheets of *Slate-Lite* should be spread on a surface to check the vein of the material and be able to sort them to get a evenly distributed wall or floor application.



### **PROTECTION**

To protect the natural stone surface apply the impregnator with a sponge roller in a very thin layer. Let the material dry for 30 minutes and the wipe off any access moisture to ensure no staining in the material surface. This can be done before and after application.

Is is advisable to wear rubber gloves while working with *EcoStone*. *EcoStone* can be processed with white glues, glass fiber glass adhesives, spray adhesives and contact adhesives.

Depending on the type of adhesive, the sheet, the wall or both should be glued. In the case of contact adhesives, the sheet hast to be put into the final position immediately, since no subsequent alterations are possible. Corrections can be made for other types of glue.

If any adhesive has come out between the seems you can use the Slate-Lite Special Cleaner to rinse the same away.

After 48 hours you can put full pressure on the material.

## **CUTTING / DRILLING**

The material can be cut with scissors or a carpet knife.

## **GROUTING**

Usually it is recommend to process *EcoStone* seamless.



#### **CORNERS**

EcoStone can be bent around corners after heating (from 40°C). In the approach EcoStone can also be deformed three-dimensionally.
