

- Location: Elva school (Tartu mnt 3, Elva)
- Check-in time to quarantine: 9:00 10:15

Practical issues – transport

Quarantine to pre-start


- Team officials may travel from quarantine to pre-start, but are not allowed to return to the quarantine.
- Teams will **not be allowed** to drive their own vehicles between quarantine zone and pre-start area.

Pre-start to Arena

- Team officials must reach to arena by foot from pre-start. (MIDDLE DISTANCE - approx. 2km).
- Team tents can be transported by baggage transport to the arena.





Practical issues

Facilities at the MIDDLE DISTANCE and RELAY PRE-START :

- Tents for shelter
- 4 toilets
- Drinking water
- Warm-up map (only in MIDDLE DISTANCE)
- Baggage transport to arena
- Teams are allowed to put up own tents



Terrain and expected winning times

- The most relevant parts of the model event terrain were those with reduced runnability/visibility.
- Estimated winning times for middle distance 35min for both classes.

- First aid is not marked on the map.







REFRESHMENT MIDDLE DISTANCE AND RELAY


- Women and Men 1 refreshment point





Closing Ceremony

When? Friday, 7.07 @ 17:00

Where? Arena Vitipalu

What? Gratitude speeches and WOC 2017 closing speech by IOF President Handing over IOF flag to next organizer of WOC





Is it allowed to visit the arena before the quarantine closes (only relay)? **YES**

How to you expect the traffic to be concerning the spectators race. Will there be any cues etc?

There can be some small delays, but very small.

How long is the distance from bus drop-off to pre-start? **It is approximately 500 meters.**

What was wrong with first start list?

That start list was based on the world ranking list (today's world ranking list instead of the one from before WOC2017).

WWWWWOC

Are the coaching zones the same in relay and middle? **Yes, they are the same.**

Is it possible to make the baggage drop-off at the arena for the teams? The drop-off will be approximately 500 metres from the arena. See updated map in the presentation.

How do we get back to cars, which are in quarantine from arena? There will be transport organized. Please inform the event office about your needs.

Can the coaches move back and forth between the quarantine and the coaching zone? The coach can move from the team area to the coaching zone, but cannot go back to the quarantine area.

W/W/W/W/OC

Will there be transport from quarantine to the arena? You have to take the transport to the pre-start and walk from there.

Is the arena layout the same for middle and relay? The coaching zone and the finish are the same and no new start triangle in the middle. There is map change in relay, there is a new triangle and the numbering continues.

How do we find a way from pre-start to arena? There will be signs from the pre-start to arena.

Are there any other controls in the terrain besides WOC controls? **No, there will be only WOC controls.**

Could you organize handwashing possibilities close to the toilets? Yes, disinfectant gel for hands will be available.

How will the outgoing runner will be aware that the incoming runner is arriving? The quarantine is in the arena, they will be able to follow everything that is going on from the speakers. Runners will be visible approximately 30 sec before the change.

Is it possible to warm up in the quarantine area next to the school in the middle distance? **YES**
