## 3. Purposes and legal basis of the processing

The "Förderverein 2. SISB e.V." processes the following personal data. For the purposes of member administration, the name, first name, address, e-mail address, telephone number and date of birth are processed. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 Para. b) GDPR. Bank details are processed for contribution management purposes. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 Para. b) GDPR.

## 4. Justified interests of the association

The "Förderverein 2. SISB e.V." has a legitimate interest in collecting personal data of the members for the purpose of fulfilling the membership duties / rights in accordance with the articles of association and the association regulations.

## 5. Recipient of personal data

The association transmits personal data of its members exclusively to the following third parties: bank of the association and tax consultant.

## 6. Transfer to third countries

There is no provision for the transfer of personal data to a third country.

## 7. Retention period

The legal retention period of personal data is 10 years.

## 8. Rights of the persons concerned

Any member of the association as a data subject has the right to request access to (Art. 15 GDPR) and rectification (Art. 16 GDPR) or erasure of personal data ('right to be forgotten') (Art. 17 GDPR) or restriction of processing concerning the data subject (Art. 18 GDPR) or to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR) as well as the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).
