



# KIIDJÄRVE-KOORASTE

---

## touring route

This touring route takes you from the Estonian town Tartu to Kiidjärve-Kooraste Recreation Area and to the sights nearby and back to Tartu. On the way you can visit several museums near Tartu, make short hikes and have a picnic on campfire sites of Kiidjärve-Kooraste Recreation Area, admire outcrops of Devonian sandstone on the banks of Ahja river in Taevaskoja, visit nearby towns, discover Estonian Space Research Centre and travel back to Tartu. Depending on how many sites you visit and how much time you decide to spend on each one, the tour can last from 1-5 days depending how thoroughly you wish to explore the area.



**1. Tartu.** You can hit the road towards Kiidjärve-Kooraste Recreation Area right away or first explore Tartu – the university town of Estonia. Since the route brings you back to Tartu, the city sightseeing can also be left at the end of the travel. **3. Estonian Aviation Museum** with the outside exposition of 26 aircrafts and 4 helicopters and inside exposition about aviation technique and launchers kit collection, more information [www.lennundusmuuseum.ee/en/](http://www.lennundusmuuseum.ee/en/).

**4. Karilatsi Open Air Museum** gives an overview of the life of the area about 100 years ago. You can see a school, a court, and an alms-house with their smaller buildings, a granary, a barn-dwelling, a cottar farm, a Dutch windmill, agricultural machinery and vehicles, more information [www.visitestonia.com/en/karilatsi-open-air-museum](http://www.visitestonia.com/en/karilatsi-open-air-museum).

**5. Kiidjärve-Kooraste Recreation Area**  
The recreation area is located less than hour drive away from Tartu. The area offers great possibilities for nature vacation: trails for shorter and longer hikes, campfire sites for picnic, beautiful rivers and lakes, berry- and mushroom-rich forests, marsh patches, extraordinary sandstone outcrops and campsites for spending the night in tent. ## HIKING ROUTE

RMK hiking route is a network of three long trails going from state border to border. These trails go through all of Estonia, through different national parks and nature reserves. You can hike the full route or pick a section you like!

One of the hiking route branches - Peraküla-Aegviidu-Ähijärve – goes through Kiidjärve-Kooraste Recreation Area. ## CAMPSITES

RMK campsites are suitable stops for the hikers to prepare a meal, take a rest and spend the night in tent. Campsites are equipped with fireplaces, tables, benches, woodsheds and dry toilets. You can choose from:
