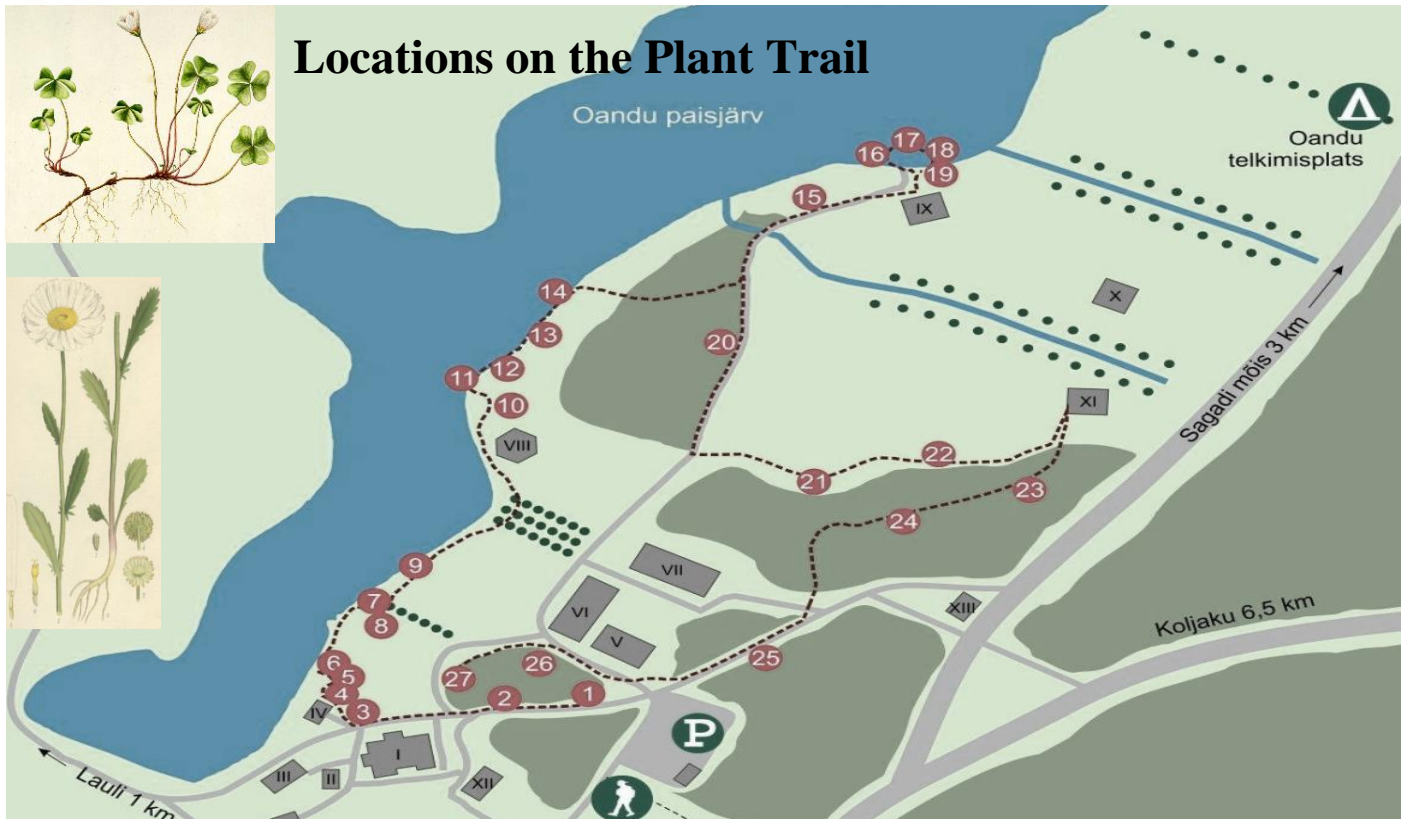


RMK Oandu Plant Trail

It may surprise you that there are so many different plant species on ~1 km Trail near Oandu Nature Centre along the shore of Oandu artificial lake. Here you can explore our spring flowers, aquatic plants, forest and meadow plants, weeds ... etc. Aquatic plants can be looked at from a boardwalk at the edge of the artificial lake, waders are not needed! The Trail is staked out with green-white signs.. Everyman's right guarantees public access to the Plant Trail. **There are 27 information boards in Estonian and English.**

The Fascinating World of Amphibians and Dragonflies: There are 5 information boards at Oandu artificial lake introducing amphibians and dragonflies, including those to be met with in Lahemaa. In spring you can listen to the croaking of frogs, a part of their wedding ceremony!
