
Green DECK

GREENDECK INSTALLATION MANUAL



Start with placing support beams on firm ground of your choice. The support beams have to be placed with <u>35 - 40 cm</u> space between them. In case you are going to place some heavy weights on your terrace the space between support beams has to be <u>30 cm</u>. Otherwise the max allowed distance is <u>40 cm</u>!



Boards are mutually connected using plastic fasteners and placing them in the groove of the board. Screw the plastic fasteners and make sure that the board fits Do not attach fasteners bolting them too tight!




5 At the place where two decking boards collide they each have to end on separate support beam. Available space between support beams. Needed space between support beams at that place is <u>2 cm!</u> The gap between decking boards has to be <u>5-10 mm!</u>

7 steps to perfect terrace!



Attach the outer decking board with metal fastener, tightening it to the support beam with stainless steal screw. Before bolting it is necessary to place metal fastener at the midpoint of support beam.



4 Remember that placing GreenDeck decking boards the gap between them has to be <u>5 mm!</u> The reason for that is, that you could remove or replace board without damaging it.



Between the outer deck and immovable object (wall, house, etc.). Leave the space: - <u>15 mm</u> if the board clings to the object in longitudinal direction and <u>7 mm</u> if the board is adhering to the object width direction.



Finally finish the terrace with GreenDeck skirting, fastening it with stainless steel screws!

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
