School-Based Health Services

The School-Based Health Center is offered here at Brass City Charter for the benefit of the students.

Please note: School-based health services work in conjunction with the care provided by your child's pediatrician and are not intended to replace regular care by your child's primary health-care provider.

If you feel you may need a checkup, here is a quick outline of the SBHC

- Location – Down the hall from the main office, next to the school nurse's office
- Available Services - The SBHC offers many services including: Medical Services, Mental Health Services, and Dental Services.
- All children enrolled in the school based health services program are eligible to receive services regardless of insurance status. For medical and behavioral health services, CHC accepts most insurance plans and there are NO out of pocket expenses. For dental services, there is a small fee if there is no insurance coverage. If you have no insurance, please ask SBHC staff about HUSKY insurance.
