3. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Elva Open Air qualifications and finals will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules.

Super finals are held on Saturday evening and will have top 8 shooters competing from the absolute standings, where goes the result of second start.

Each country can register as many mixed teams as wanted. Mix teams can consist of athletes from two different countries. If you have an athlete who would like to shoot a mixed team event, but do not have another team member, then you can register athlete as "lottery mixed team participant" and organizers will try to find a partner for that athlete.

Maximum number of individual participants: 280 Maximum number of mix teams: 60 (Air Rifle) and 60 (Air Pistol)

Organizers reserve the right to make changes to the program and rules if necessary.

4. EQUIPMENT CONTROL

Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules using approved and calibrated instruments.

Pre-competition equipment control is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to the ISSF Rules.

5. ENTRY PROCESS AND FEES

6. SHOOTING RANGES AND VENUES

Competition will be held in Elva Sport Hall. The venues is 20 minute car drive distance from Tartu city centre, 210km from Tallinn Airport and 225km from Riga Airport. Elva Sport Hall address: Tartu mnt 3/1, Elva, Tartu County, Estonia.

Air Rifle and Air Pistol disciplines will be held in a 10 m range which was built by the organizers especially for this competition. There will be 40 firing points that are all equipped with SIUS electronic targets. Finals will take place at the same location.

Catering is organized both in the Sport Hall and it is also possible to eat at other eating establishments in Elva, which are located within a radius of 300m from the Sport Hall.

Weapons, ammunition and equipment storage room will be located within the Sport Hall.
