From Hotel to Art Gallery

Tucked away in the heart of the Carinthian Nockberge, surrounded by forests, meadows and small biotopes, you'll find the art-lodge - a place where art and nature are founding a symbiosis with future.

The art-lodge project was recendly transformed from an award-winning four-star art hotel to what the owners call KUNSTHAUS. Parts of the Liesenfeld/Jordan Collection of contemporary art with a focus on young Austrian and German positions are now shown in the former hotel rooms and hallways. Every Summer an exhibition is organised in the Off-Space that was created in the former kitchen and storage areas. This year, the young artist Terese Kasalicky (*1988/Klagenfurt, lives in Vienna), who was awarded the Carinthia State Fine Arts Prize in 2024, will use the exhibition space with her works of sculpture, drawing and research.

The growing sculpture park on the approximately 1.5 hectare alpine meadows invites you to go hiking and enjoy art outdoors. Visitors will find over 20 large-format sculptures and installations here.

In addition to the art on display, there are also readings, videos and performances. As part of the Artist in Residency Program, which has been running for over 12 years now, there is also the opportunity to talk to young artists.

The sculpture park is open daily in the summer season from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., the KUNSTHAUS opens on Saturday and Sunday from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Since the collector couple Liesenfeld-Jordan wants to make access to modern art as easy and possible for everyone, the entry is free of admission.

In addition to the art, four TinyHouses, that are integrated into the sculpture park and have been redesigned by four artists, are also available for rent. Here, the focus is on enjoying nature and culture as a direct experience: Although there are all amenities in terms of accessibility and comfort, instead of WiFi and TV the chirping of birds, morning sun, real books and mountain views from the bed can be experienced. Cost per night from 99 EUR for 2 people).
