Accommodation

Lydia Hotel 4* Superior – located next to the Town Hall in the centre of Tartu.

Amenities: spa lounge, fitness club, restaurant Hõlm, event centre. Prices from 90€

vSpa Hotel 4* – located in the city centre in the business and shopping centre Kvartal.

Amenities: wellness and sauna centre, fitness club, restaurant Joyce. Prices from 85€

London Hotel 4* – located in the Old Town close to restaruant and leisure opportunities. Prices from 85€

<u>Pallas Hotel 3* Superior</u> – located in the city centre at a crossway of the Old Town and comtemporaty buildings.

The interior design exhibits 1920s art. Prices from 60€

<u>Dorpat Hotel</u> – located in the city centre business area next to the bus station.

Amenities: spa treatments, Dorpat restaurant and conference centre. Prices from 60€

<u>Tartu Hotel</u> – located in the city centre next to the bus station.

International Transportation

Tartu Airport – located 10km from the city center, there are daily flights by Finnair to and from Helsinki Airport where there are connecting flights from all over the world.

Tallinn Airport – just 2.5h from Tartu, Tallinn Airport offers many European connections. Arriving in Tallinn, you can check out Tallinn and its business ecosystem.

Riga Airport – the largest airport in the Baltics is a 3.5h drive or bus ride away. You may find that some airlines offer the most comfortable connections with Riga.

Regional Transportation

Bus – you can find bus transfers from nearby airports directly to Tartu.

Train – a train from Tallinn to Tartu takes around 2 hours.
