



KADRIORG PARK RULES

- Visitors must follow the instructions of Kadriorg Park staff and park guards.
- Pedestrians have the right of way on park paths.
- During strong winds, being under large trees is at your own risk.
- Using the park's attractions is at your own risk.
- You must immediately clean up after your pet in the park.

PROHIBITED IN THE PARK:

- Breaking or otherwise damaging flowers, trees, and bushes;
- Entering flowerbeds, restricted areas or walking on the walls;
- Being on unmown grass;
- Littering;
- Polluting canals, ponds, and fountains;
- Damaging or destroying park property (e.g., waste bins, flower vases, benches, lights, etc.);
- Creating graffiti;
- Erecting unauthorized structures;
- Consuming alcohol and narcotic substances;
- Being in the park with a bare torso, in swimwear, or underwear;
- Swimming or fishing in canals, ponds, or fountains;
- Walking pets without a leash;
- Walking dogs in marked prohibited areas, except for guide and assistance dogs, e.g., around Swan Pond and the Japanese Garden;
- Swimming, fishing, washing or bathing pets in the ponds;
- Feeding the park's animals and birds;
- Camping, overnight stays, or making fires;
- Creating loud noise, including honking car horns;
- Riding horses or horse-drawn carriages.

WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM KADRIORG PARK, THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED IN THE PARK:

- Driving and parking motorised vehicles on park paths and green areas;
- Taking photos or filming for advertising purposes;

- Posting notices or advertisements without authorisation;
- Engaging in business activities, except with a special permit from the district government;
- Organizing events, sports games, and training sessions.
