INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTE

1. TO VOTE YOU <u>MUST</u> COMPLETELY
BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) TO THE LEFT
OF YOUR CHOICE.

An oval (•) blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.

- 2. To cast a write-in vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval (•) to the left of the line provided and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.
- 3. To vote in FAVOR of a Question, fill in the oval (●) to the left of the word YES. To vote AGAINST a Question, fill in the oval (●) to the left of the word NO.
- 4. Use only black ink pen.
- **5.** If you make a mistake DO NOT ERASE. Ask for a new ballot.

For Absentee Ballot Voters: "The official absentee voter ballot shall state that an elector who receives an absentee ballot pursuant to section 1301 and whose voted ballot is not timely received by the commission and who, on Election Day, is capable of voting at the appropriate polling place may only vote on Election Day by provisional ballot unless the elector brings the elector's absentee ballot to the elector's polling place, remits the ballot and the envelope containing the declaration of the elector to the Judge of Elections to be spoiled and signs a statement subject to the penalties under 18 PA.C.S. § 4904 (relating to the unsworn falsification to the authorities) to the same effect."

For Mail-in Ballot Voters: "The official mailvoter ballot shall state that a voter who receives a mail-in ballot under section 1301-D and whose voted mail-in ballot is not timely received may only vote on Election Day by provisional ballot unless the elector brings the elector's mail-in ballot to the elector's polling place, remits the ballot and the envelope containing the declaration of the elector to the Judge of Elections to be spoiled and signs a statement subject to the penalties of 18 PA.C.S.§ 4904 (relating to the unsworn falsification to the authorities) to the same effect.'
