VAIVARA BLUE HILLS MUSEUM

SINIMÄE, VAIVARA PARISH. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 17-21

17.30 Lecture "Eesti sõjalised autasud 1918–1940" ("Estonian Military Decorations 1918-1940")

The permanent exhibition is dedicated to the 1944 battles of World War II on the Narva front and in the Sinimäed ("Blue Hills") of Vaivara. The exposition includes weapons, uniforms, personal belongings of soldiers, photos and other items from the front. The exhibition hall is also screening newsreels and historical documentaries. The main focus of the museum is war history, but the history of Vaivara Parish is also documented.

KUKRUSE POLAR MANOR

KUKRUSE MANOR, TOILA PARISH. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23

The exposition at Kukruse Polar Manor tells two tales through the past of one family. On the one hand, there is the tale of a passion so great that it gives birth to history. On the other hand, there is the tale of how a passionate desire to go down in history can lead to one's doom. These are the tales of the Von Toll family.

Kukruse is the oldest manor in Ida-Viru County. The finding of oil shale in its park marked the beginning of mining and industrial use this mineral resource in the region.

IISAKU PARISH MUSEUM

The museum gives an overview of folk costume patterns, embroideries and items of various peoples living in the region.
