ESTONIAN MUSEUM RAILWAY

LAVASSAARE, AUDRU PARISH. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-22.

The Museum Railway is open for the Museum Night. Attractions for visitors include the steam locomotive (discount tickets: 10.-/8.-/5.-) and rail push trolleys (tickets: 7.-/5.-). Children under 6 can attend for free. Entertainment is provided by the local female choir. Guests are also welcome to visit our cafe, souvenir shop and a video exhibition on the history of narrow-gauge railway.

KIRSI VINTAGE VEHICLE MUSEUM IN VIRTSU

LINNAMÄE TEE 11, VIRTSU. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23.

PÄRNU OLD TOWN ONE-NIGHT MUSEUM - "VB KINGA- JA KOTIÄRI" SHOE MUSEUM

RÜÜTLI 32, PÄRNU. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23.

The one-night museum will be hosting Hazgal and Krislyn from Wanakuramuse Nahakamber (Wanakuramus' Leather Crafts), who will guide us deep into the exciting, beautiful and pattern-rich world of leatherwork. Visitors can witness beauty, acquire leather-related knowledge and try out their own skills.

PÄRNU MUSEUM

AIDA 3, PÄRNU. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23.

The overarching theme of our Museum Night exhibitions is TEXTILE. The exhibitions on display are “Light and Shadow. Contemporary Damask”, Estonian Textile Artists’ Association’s “Kaadrid” (“Frames”) and “Olustvere olemised” (“Happenings of Olustvere”) in the foyer.

There will also be Museum Night workshops, where we discuss folk costume patterns and weave patterns of string figures together with a friend. For the first time, Museumiklubi Musse (Museum Club Musse) will be presenting prime examples of its culinary patterns.

PÄRNU TOURIST GUIDES ASSOCIATION

AIDA 3, PÄRNU. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 19-21

In the framework of the Museum Night, the guides of Pärnu will be introducing their work in Pärnu Museum and offering thematic tours of the city.

At **21.00**, we will head off from Pärnu Museum to the walking tour “Mustriid tänaval” (“Patterns in the Street”, in Estonian), in the course of which we will look for traces of times past and explain several mysterious patterns in the street pavement. The duration of the walk is approximately one hour.

TORI MUSEUM

PÄRNU MNT 12, TORI BOROUGH. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23.

Tori Museum is collecting the history and contemporary reflections of Tori, and the related material objects. On the Museum Night, we will be celebrating the birthdays of August Pulst, Tori Museum and the granary building with a cake. There will be a workshop “Mustriid, mis mõjutavad mõtteid” (“Patterns Affecting our Thoughts”). Visitors will be served by a cafe.

SELJAMETSA MUSEUM

Seljametsa, Paikuse borough. Opening hours for the Museum Night: **18-23**.

The local history museum of Paikuse Parish will feature a retro-themed pancake cafe and workshop on making patterned keepsakes. Tours of the museum at every full hour.

KIHNU MUSEUM

LINAKÜLA, KIHNU. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 18-23.

This year, the Museum Night in Kihnu will examine the patterns of other indigenous Finno-Ugric peoples. We will open the exhibition “Soome-Ugri rahvaste eluhetked” (“Moments in the Life of Finno-Ugric Peoples”) by Udmurt painter Stanislav Antipov. Erzya-Moksha folk ensemble “Kilejne” (“Little Birch Tree”) will perform old songs in Erzyan. Natalia Abrosimova, an Erzyan, will present and teach a workshop on Finno-Ugric ornaments. Folk costumes, dolls and other toys are on display.

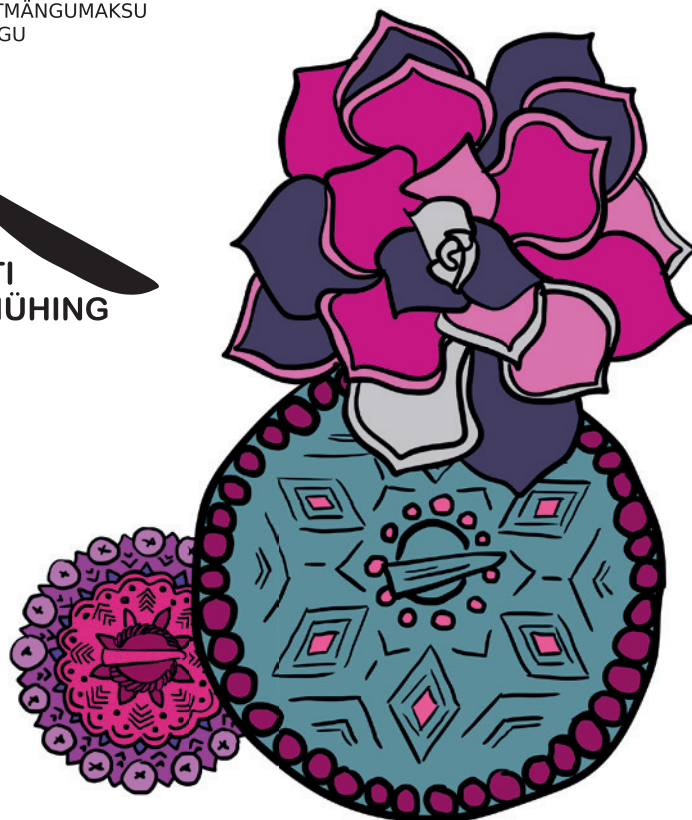
