VALGA MUSEUM

VABADUSE 8, VALGA. OPENING HOURS FOR THE MUSEUM NIGHT: 19-22.

The traditional bus tour, organised by Valga Museum, will depart at **10.00** on 18 May (advance booking required). The bus passes through Parmu Eco-Village, Metsavenna Farm, Ähijärve Visitor Centre and Hallimäe Farm. The bus returns to Valga approximately by **17.00**.

The permanent exhibition of the museum and gallery exhibitions are open for visitors. The museum gallery features works by the students of Valga Art School and the exhibition “Piste piste järele” (“Stitch After Stitch”) that introduces the handicraft of Finno-Ugric women, ornaments and their meanings. The museum also hosts different workshops and activities. There will be guided tours of the museum, including one tour in Latvian. Valga Museum and Valka Local History Museum are connected by a little yellow train and the two museums are co-organising an orienteering game. After the Valga Museum closes its doors, everyone is invited to Valka Local History Museum, where the winners of the orienteering game receive prizes at **22.30**.

LÄÄNE COUNTY

17.00 Departure from Haeska Manor (Haeska, Kiideva, Puise, Panga Centre, Parila, Ridala hill, Asuküla, Mägari, Museum of Coastal Swedes in Haapsalu). The return bus departs at 21.15 from the Museum of Coastal Swedes towards Haeska.

18.30 Departure from Võnnu Manor. (Võnnu Manor, Üsse village, Uuemõisa, Museum of Coastal Swedes in Haapsalu). The return bus departs at **22.45** from the Museum of Coastal Swedes towards Võnnu.

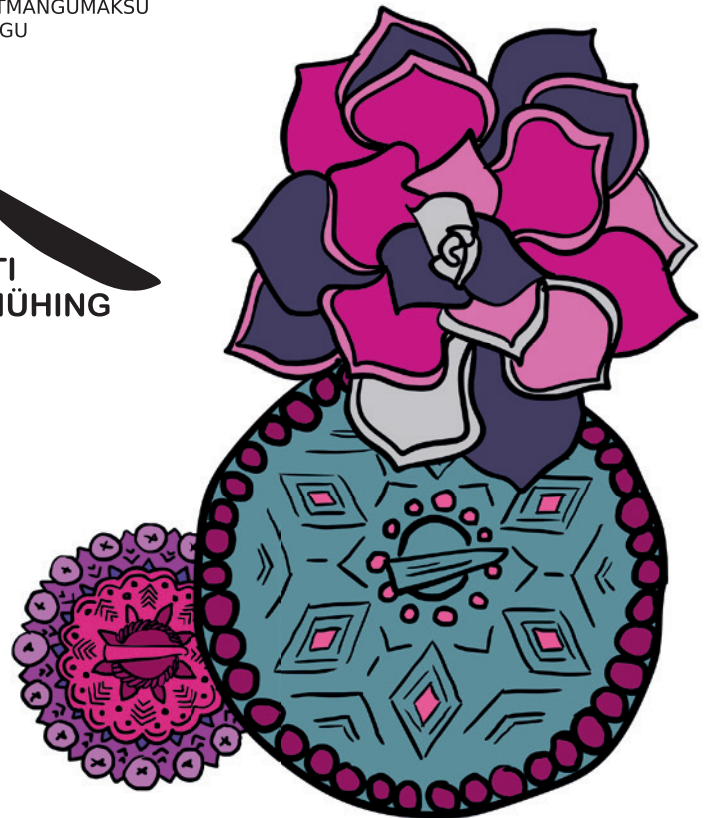
