The Peipsimaa heritage trail is for those who are interested to learn about the different cultures and dialects of Peipsimaa

The PeipsiRing project together with its partners has developed the Lake Peipsi Heritage Trail during the year. A heritage-themed trail and map has been completed, which gives a first overview of the museums and cultural heritage centers in Lake Peipsi and the attractions located in the region, introducing the region in different dialects. On November 4, journalists and tourism experts will visit Northern lake Peipsi land.

The paper map of the Peipsimaa Heritage Trail and the online map on the website of the Peipsi Center for Transboundary Cooperation provides an overview of the points of interest in Peipsimaa based on the linguistic and cultural characteristics of the region. On the basis of the map, you can get to know, for example, Kodavere dialect, Vanasuliste dialect, Räpina dialect, Setu language and others. with tracks.

From October, those interested can also visit the project's traveling exhibition "Peipsiveere keelrikkus", which travels from one cultural center to another and provides an overview of some of the dialects of Peipsimaa.
