Short summary: Heino Lubja Weight Museum is a museum in Mustvee. The museum has exhibited more than 120 scales, nearly 60 railing trees and numerous scales. It is founded by Heino Lubi who worked as a scales maker for more than 30 years. The collection includes over 120 various scales, about 50 steelyards, a great number of metal and ceramic weights and other things related to scales.

In addition to scales made in Estonia, Heino Lubi's collection also features scales made in the Soviet Union and Poland. The museum also displays several contemporary scales which help to understand the history of scales.

Short summary: The lisaku Museum Was established in 1975. The founders of the museum were Helmi and Daniel Vardja who, with the schoolchildren of lisaku, laid the foundation for an interesting and informative exposition. The museum gives an overview of Ida Viru history, culture, and nature, The exposition in former ministry-schoolhouse, built 1914, suggest to look at different interiors.

The latest part of the exhibition the history of Poluverniks (Half believers) They were Lutherans who kept the orthodox fasts. They spoke The Votian, Estonian, Russian mixed language and their material culture was different from Estonian and Russian one. The visitors get acquainted with a living mode at the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century in the threshing barn and the handcraft room. The classroom suggests a view of culture, education and pastorate history through the life of Robert Theodor Hansen, the Composer of the melody "Ema süda" (The Mother's heart) The teacher's room gives a view about a clerk's life at the beginning of 1900 s.

An exposition in the firefighting room acquaints the firemen's activities from the beginning of the 20th century to the present day.

The collection of stuffed animals and birds from Alutaguse in the nature room is interesting and varied. In addition to the permanent exposition, visitors have an opportunity to look at the temporary exhibitions.

Short summary: A narrow-gauge Sonda-Mustvee railway passed through Avinurme during 1926–1972. It was a true 50-year-long prosperity era for the villages located near the route. Today, a section of 178.5 metres of the former railway, the rail brigde, and the rail vehicle have been restored.

All those who are interested are welcomed to take a nostalgic train ride from May to October, meaning the railway is opened when the weather is warm enough and the door of the locomotive can be opened and the railway is closed when the door of the locomotive freezes shut.

Short summary:

Since 1885, a snow-white castle with its towers has caught the eye in the heart of Alatskivi. The main building of the manor, built on the model of Balmoral Castle in Scotland, was designed by the local manor owner Arved Georg von Nolcken himself. Over time, the mansion has had various functions, but since 2012 the restored castle has been open to all guests in all its glory.

- On the ground floor visitors can walk in the living area of the baron's family and get a glimpse of the atmosphere of that time. Also, short introduction of the history of the manorial life and restoration process is given.
- On the basement floor visitors can see the permanent exhibition of the manors of Old Tartumaa and an exposition of wax figures of the manor servants. There is also a ceramics workshop on that floor.
- On the second floor there is a museum dedicated to the renowned Estonian composer Eduard Tubin.
- The Restaurant of Alatskivi Castle offers different cuisines in the restaurant on the first floor, and special accommodation in four suites on the second floor..

Juhan Liiv Museum provides an overview of the history of the poet Juhan Liiv and the surrounding area. Their farm gives an idea of the life of the Estonian peasantry in the early 20th century. The permanent exhibition 'If I Were a Poet' gives a thorough overview of the life and works of Juhan Liiv. It studies the role of Juhan Liiv in the Estonian psyche and explores some of the myths related to the poet. You can learn about his works through sound and video recordings. The exhibition 'Kodavere – a Good Big Chunk of Parish' introduces the past of the area and different cultures: the Kodavere dialect, Vadja heritage, the local Russian Orthodox community, and Baltic German nobility.

Short summary:

Räpina Local History and Gardening Museum is located in the heart of the former manor of Räpina. The museum is located on the first floor of a majestic building completed in the middle of the 19th century. The exhibitions introduce Räpina manor and parish, gardening education and one of the oldest paper mills in Europe. Visitors are offered a brief overview of the history of Räpina, which includes exciting events since Räpina was first mentioned in 1582. The museum has various exhibitions in the form of photographs, texts and old objects. The visitor can figure out the names and purposes of things from time immemorial and try out old techniques. On a guided walk in and around Sillapää Castle, we will visit the species-rich manor park and the collection garden of Räpina Gardening School.

Short summary:

The Art Nouveau summer residence of General Nikolai Reek on the shores of Lake Õrsava is undoubtedly an architectural gem of the North Military Training Camp, which has been restored in a way as close to the original as possible.

Since June 2020, the Värska Visitor Centre has been operating in the building. The exposition of the centre provides information about the Pechory Northern Military Training Camp, founded here in the 1920s, the events of the War of Independence, and the use of medicinal mud and mineral water in this resort area.

The visitor centre has a small café and you can rent bicycles, boats, pedal boats, or skates here, depending on the season, and there is also a car park for caravans.

The Värska Farm Museum enables the visitors to learn about the farm architecture, old tools and rich collection of handicraft items dating from the end of the 19th and beginning of the 20th century. The exposition comprises a half-enclosed yard, a dwelling, storehouses for clothes, grain and food, a bam with a hay shed, a workshop, other sheds, a smoke sauna, a pottery, a smithy, a barn and kiln house and a tea house. The majority of the buildings are original and originate from Nothern Setumaa. The museum also organises temporary special exhibitions. Visitors can participate in various events, such as winter holidays, Seto lace days, Folk tales' nights and celebrations of folk calendar holidays.

The museum has a spacious yard and a beautiful park with a study trail, located just a few hundred metres from the Russian border.
