He created The Shed Distillery of PJ Rigney, with its medieval copper pot stills, and began a quest to fuse oriental botanicals with the local Irish ones. As it turned out, they got on very well indeed.

The result of this passionate exploration is Drumshanbo Gunpowder Irish Gin – unique, extraordinary and as remarkable as the elusive creature PJ has occasionally glimpsed in the fields, the Drumshanbo Jackalope.

## Signature Serve

A Wedge of Fresh Red Grapefruit  
40ml – Drumshanbo Gunpowder Irish Gin  
140ml – Chilled Premium Tonic

Fill a glass tumbler with cubed ice, add a generous measure of Drumshanbo Gunpowder Irish Gin, top it with chilled premium tonic and garnish with a thick wedge of fresh, red grapefruit to emphasise the refreshing citrus notes.
