



SALTO INCLUSION & DIVERSITY (YOUTH)

HIGHLIGHT#1

The **ID Forum 2023** was a conference that brought 120 inclusion workers, NA ID officers, policymakers and researchers to reflect, share practices, tools and resources, and discuss strategies for driving more inclusion and diversity into the EU Youth Programmes.


SPI Harvesting Conference - SALTO I&D organised the Harvesting Conference in the framework of the Strategic Partnership for Inclusion. It brought together 21 youngsters (18-30), 39 youth workers, and 26 NA representatives. The conference offered a space to harvest the impact of and the practices that engage with working on inclusion and diversity in the EU Youth Programmes. We did so by sharing methods, tools, and approaches, and practices.

HIGHLIGHT#3

ID Talks Year on Mental Health - In 2023, SALTO Inclusion & Diversity Resources Centre and the Mental Health in Youth Work project jointly announced a series of "ID Talks on Mental Health" - 10 online workshops, with the spring 2023 ID Talks addressing "Understanding Mental Health" and the autumn 2023 edition focussing on "Discovering Mental Health Practices". Aim is to contribute to the discussion on the importance of youth mental health and wellbeing, as well as to highlight youth workers' role in young people's wellbeing.

Climate justice LTA


This long-term activity was the result of a series of focus groups with NAs and a seminar about the links between Green & Inclusion. The project is built on the idea of supporting the most vulnerable people, who are the most affected by climate change, while at the same time don't have a seat at the table nor are unable to take part in the green transition. The project will spread consist of training courses online and offline, study visits and PBA spreading over 2 years and divided into 3 main topics: (1) Transnational partnerships and cooperation, (2) Capacity building & awareness raising, (3) Knowledge building and retention

WORKPLANS 2024 #2

To address the topic of cultural diversity SALTO ID is planning to select a few topics like anti-racism, interfaith dialogue..., work on each for 2 years and make a series out of it. In Dec 2023 we are closing anti-racism series and in 2024 we start addressing the topic of interfaith dialogue.

WORKPLANS 2024 #3

SALTO ID will organise **a training on inclusive events**. This training will offer space to youth workers and interested NA staff to share practices and knowledge on organising accessible and inclusive events. Q2, Luxemburg. Hosted by the Luxembourg National Agency.



HIGHLIGHT#1

SALTO SEE (SOUTH EAST EUROPE)

Coordination of the Beyond Borders SNAC, which aims to strengthen and support the cooperation with neighbouring partner countries within the Programmes. In 2023, SALTO SEE supported two PBAs hosted by the NAs from CZ (ESC) and SI (E+ for accredited organisations) to promote partnerships.

We further developed the **Beyondb.eu website** (hosted by SALTO EECA).


We also involved **RAY to carry out a study (RAY-NPC)** to collect insights from organisations in Programme countries about the projects with partner countries (needs, challenges, benefits etc.). The aim is to feed into a process of drafting recommendations for futher support activities and Programme development (results expected in spring 2024; concept paper attached).

HIGHLIGHT#2

Within Volunteering SNAC, hosting of **Volunteering Conference** in October 2023 in Podgorica, Montenegro. The Volunteering Conference is coordinated by the ESC Resource Centre and aims to define recommendations for the further development of the ESC. SALTO SEE decided to host the conference in the Western Balkan region in order to ensure that voices from the partner regions are heard in this process.

HIGHLIGHT#3

In the frame of **Europe Goes Local**, development of a **network of 12 municipalities in Albania**, **Bosnia and Herzegovina**, **Montenegro and Kosovo** and support for the development of youth work, youth participation and youth policy at local level through mentoring and participation in international support activities organised by NAs within EGL.



WORKPLANS 2024 #1

SALTO SEE (SOUTH EAST EUROPE)

- **Beyond Borders will be continued in 2024**. In particular, the second NA/SALTO staff meeting on cooperation with partner countries will be hosted from 20 22 February in Tiblisi, Georgia by SALTO EECA.
- A stakeholder conference aiming to develop recommendations for the further development
 of the cooperation with partner countries will be hosted by the DE NA in Bonn, Germany, from 14


 16 September 2024. It should also build on the outcomes of the RAY-NPC study, which should be
 finalised in 2024.
- Other activities, such as the development of Beyondb.eu and support for partnership-building through a PBA organised by SALTO EuroMed (in Jordan or Tunesia), will be continued.

WORKPLANS 2024 #2

Regular work carried out in the frame of ESC: Quality Label process and TEC for volunteers and organisations in the Western Balkan region, all of which are carried out throughout the year. Given the fragility of the youth sector, even more dramatically so after the Covid years, it has become difficult to engage organisations in the ESC programme and there is a stronger need for support, due the long process needed to get involved and the limited possibilities to take initiative (since organisations cannot apply for projects). In response to this situation, SALTO SEE has initiated and already successfully implemented a so-called »Buddy support« programme, which it will also implement in 2024, where one organisation that already has a QL but difficulties to get started is paired up with an organisation in another country that is ready to offer support (and thereby possibly also build a new partnership).

WORKPLANS 2024 #3

SALTO SEE has engaged with topics of citizenship education (education for European democratic citizenship, critical youth citizenship, EduForEurope etc.), because of the relevance to strengthen civic participation as well as reflections on European values in the Western Balkan region. In spring 2024, it will host a **meeting of experts**, in cooperation with NAs that have also engaged with this topic, to further explore the concept of "Education for European Democratic Citizenship", create synergies between the different processes on this topic and define further actions, esp. considering the implications of current geopolitical developments.

Onboarding package for new ESC staff

ESC space navigator: During the ESC staff meeting and the Colleague support meeting for solidarity project officers exchanging with colleagues we noticed that a basic onboarding package would support new NA colleagues in navigating through the ESC programme and the offers towards NA's and beneficiaries our SALTO provides. 

International Solidarity project meet-up 2023

We saw a need to link the local solidarity projects to the wider European dimension and make them feel that they are part of a greater European picture. 111 fitting participants applied and we could accommodate at the end 33. Other funding formats in the field of youth were introduced (YP projects, discover EU inclusion, ESC volunteering, KA2) and till now already five projects as direct outcome of the event were approved. Some participants joined afterwards the Europeers network and the impact of the relatively small event was surprisingly big for us. The format will be hosted in 24 by the Czech NA allowing more participants to join.


Community impact conference (hosted in Bulgaria June 2024)





Adventure in Education.

After a number of PBAs and two methodological seminars, in cooperation with other teams active in adventure education, we plan to make an impact research among ex-participants, prepare a booklet with results and inspirations for adventurous (emotional, non-cognitive) aspects in learning and most probably an assessment tool (maybe gamified), allowing events' teams to asses their activities in regards to such elements in a learning process.
