# 1. General Information

Acro Clube da Maia and the Maia City, with the support of the Portuguese Gymnastics Federation and the Portuguese Sports Institute, are pleased to present the

# 17<sup>th</sup> Maia International Acro Cup (MIAC'23)

The Competition will take place in the city of Maia from <u>8 to 12 March 2023</u>. **MIAC'23** is opened to National, Regional and Club Teams.

There will be a Team Competition for Youth, Age Group 1, Age Group 2, Junior and Senior. The Team classification is defined by the sum of the marks of 3 pairs or groups (no matter if they are repeated; example: 3 Mix Pairs or 2 Men Four and 1 Women Pair).

This competition is being prepared in accordance with the FIG regulations and rules with the following age groups and categories:

# 4. Delegation Size

Each delegation may include:

- 1 Head of delegation / 1 Team Manager / 1 Doctor / 1 Physiotherapist
- Unlimited Coaches
- Unlimited acrobatic pairs / groups
- COMPULSORY: At least 1 judge 300 € penalty fee if no judge is not presented

(<u>International Judges</u> have <u>50% discount</u> in the accommodation package)

#### **Competition Program** 5.

#### Begginer (Iniciado) NEW CATEGORY - COMBINED - 2 minutes of maximum duration Pairs:

- 2 balance elements from 11-16 difficulty tables (2 x 3" hold) + 1 optional element from FIG tables (1 x 3" hold) and
- 1 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables
- MAXIMUM of 5 Pair elements

#### Groups:

- 1 pyramid from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG tables (only 2 static holds of 3" are required in the routine) and
- 1 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables (Only 1 element with start and finish lay down on bases arms.)
- MAXIMUM of 4 Group elements
- OPTIONAL element can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but not from the same ROWS used on the compulsory elements.

Individual: Each gymnast must perform 3 individual elements - no matter if is Balance or Tumbling and no matter if they are different.

#### **Youth** – COMBINED - 2 minutes of maximum duration Pairs:

- 2 balance elements from 11-16 difficulty tables (2 x 3" hold) + 1 optional element from FIG tables (1 x 3" hold) and
- 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables; 1 element must be a catch and maximum 1 dismount.

#### Groups:

- 1 pyramid from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG tables (2 static holds of 3" are required in the routine) and
- 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables; 1 element must be a catch and maximum 1 dismount.
- OPTIONAL can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but not from the same ROWS used on the compulsory elements.
- MAXIMUM of 6 Pair/Group elements.
- Individual: Each gymnast must perform 3 individual elements no matter if is Balance or Tumbling and no matter if they are different.

# JUNIOR BASE NEW CATEGORY - COMBINED - 2 minutes of maximum duration

- Minimum of 3 balance elements (3 x 3" static holds)
- Minimum of 3 dynamic elements; for the DYNAMIC, 1 must be a catch and maximum 2 dismounts.

#### Groups:


- Minimum of 3 static holds on a minimum of 2 separate pyramids (3 x 3" static holds)
- Minimum of 3 dynamic elements; for the DYNAMIC, 1 element must be a catch and maximum 2 dismounts. Only 1 element with start and land lay down on bases arms.
- MAXIMUM of 8 Pair/Group elements.
- Pairs/Groups must reach 20 points in difficulty (otherwise a penalty of 1.0 is given)
- Individual: Each gymnast must perform 3 individual elements no matter if is Balance or Tumbling and no matter if they are different.

Age Group 1 / Age Group 2 / Junior / Senior – FIG Rules (ages according to page 2)

All Pair / Groups from Youth, Age Group 1 and 3 will be able to perform up to 3 routines.

All PG from all other Age Group 2 and 4, Junior and Senior will be able to perform up to 4 routines.

If there are less than 20 PG: 12 or more = 8 PG in Final / less than 12 = 6 PG in Final

Example: 40 Trios -> 20 best in the ranking on Semi-Final -> Top 6 of Semi-Final -> Final

# 8. Deadlines for Entries and Finance Obligations

Provisional entry (not compulsory): up to <u>8 December</u> (NO PAYMENTS)

Definitive entry: up to <u>8 January</u> (<u>30% ACCOMODATION + ENTRY FEE</u>)

Nominative entry: up to 8 February – (NO PAYMENTS NEED)

THE REMAINING PAYMENT MUST BE MADE ON ACCREDITATION OR IN ADVANCE BY WIRE TRANSFER

- The delegations are responsible for covering travel expenses, accommodation (via Organizing Committee), meals and entry fee.
- The entry fee is not refundable.
- The accommodations are only refundable if cancellations are made until 8 February.
- All delegations must bring (at least) 1 Judge

#### **CLASS A Hotel**

#### (Example - Hotel Axis Porto Business & Spa - 15' from Sports hall by bus)

#### (Example - Hotel Star Inn - 20' from Sports hall by bus)

#### (Example - Park Hotel Valongo - 45' from Sports hall by bus)

#### CLASS C Hotel - 20' from Sports hall

(Limited to 50 people)

Single / Double 75 Euro / night / person

<u>Full board</u> is included in accommodation packages. Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Lunch and dinner will be served in the Sports Complex, close to the competition hall.

The prices charged for the hotel rooms will not exceed the usual hotel rates (including Full Board – breakfast, lunch, dinner – and transportation). Hotel rooms will be allocated on a "first come, first serve" basis.

<u>Transfers</u> by bus to and from the **Porto airport** and **Campanha Train Station** (Oporto) to the official hotel, as well as from the official hotel to the competition hall, will be provided to all delegations included in the Accommodation Package.

Accommodation will be reserved after fulfilled the financial obligations at the DEFINITIVE ENTRY: 30% accommodation package + entry fee.

#### 11. Visa

If you need an official invitation to obtain a visa to travel to Portugal, please contact the OC as soon as possible.

#### 12. Insurance

All delegations are responsible for ensuring the appropriate coverage against accidents and illness. The OC will verify the certificates of insurance of all delegation members upon arrival at accreditation. All persons who cannot provide proof of adequate insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete.

#### 13. Medical Services

A physiotherapist or sport masseur and Red Cross personnel will be present during competitions. A physiotherapist or sport masseur will be present during all training sessions.

#### 14. Media Representatives

Media representatives (journalists, photographers, TV) must request a special accreditation from the OC. <u>Please contact the OC before 1<sup>st</sup> February to be eligible to a Media Accreditation</u>. The media will be assigned special areas and working conditions.

# 15. Accreditation / Tariff sheets / Music

The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the competition and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required to wear accreditation cards at all times.

The accreditation is personal, non-transferable and compulsory to control access to training and competition hall, official transport, lunches and dinners.

Without your accreditation card, you cannot pass the security control and you cannot participate in lunches, dinners, etc. So, if you lose your accreditation card, you will have to buy a new one for the price of 250 €.

Additional accreditations can be requested. The price of 250 € per extra accreditation includes lunch and dinner (Wednesday to Sunday), free entry to competition, training and Farewell Party.

When all the commitments are fulfilled, all delegation members will receive their accreditations. All participants and officials are required to wear the accreditations at the all times.

Delegations will receive accreditation based on nominative entry upon arrival at the Competition Venue.

On the Nominative Entry form you will be asked to insert a **photo of each** delegation member by the Nominative Entry deadline (8<sup>th</sup> February).

The specification of the photo should be as follows:

File format; JPG, JPEG, PNG, TIFF

Dimensions: 190 pixels wide x 250 pixels high

File name: NOC Surname Firstname (example POR Silva Antonio.jpg)

The <u>tariff sheets</u> must be made on ACROCOMPANION software and uploaded until the <u>March 1<sup>st</sup> – PLEASE IDENTIFY THE TARIFF SHEETS WITH THE P/G NUMBER</u>

The competition music MUST be uploaded in your dropbox until the deadline. Use ONLY MP3 format. <u>Other formats will be discarded by the system</u>.

The <u>music</u> must be sent to the Dropbox folder of each delegation created specially for that until the <u>March</u> 1<sup>st</sup>. After this date OC will not recheck the Dropbox for any changes.

# 16. Orientation Meeting

The orientation meeting will take place on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> March on the City Hall at 14:00. This meeting is for Head of Delegation, Team Managers, Judges and Coaches. Each head of delegation will receive the official competition plan.

# 17. Prize Money & Medal Award Ceremonies

All finalists are requested to participate in Medal Award Ceremonies. They are requested to appear in competition attire. **Top 3** will receive medals.

There will be a Team Competition (Age Group, Junior and Senior).

There will be *PRIZE MONEY* of more than 10.000€ in for the <u>AGE GROUP 2,</u> <u>JUNIOR and SENIOR Competition</u> as following:

1<sup>st</sup> place – 150 EUR (for each partner of the Pair/Group)

2<sup>nd</sup> place – 100 EUR (for each partner of the Pair/Group)

3<sup>rd</sup> place – 50 EUR (for <u>each partner</u> of the Pair/Group)

For be eligible to Prize Money award, P/G must perform scores equal or above 78,00 (Balance + Dynamic + Final) – mark without DIFFICULTY.

**Special Prize Money Award (Age Group 2, Junior and Senior)** will be given to the best <u>Balance and Tempo routines</u> (sum of the Balance and Tempo overall marks): 150 EUR (for the Pair/Group).

**Special Prize Money Award (Senior)** will be given to the <u>higher difficulty score</u> in Competition: <u>150 EUR</u> (for the Pair/Group).

# 18. Farewell Party

A farewell party will be organized and will be followed by disco and dance. All delegations that have booked their accommodation with the OC are invited to participate without additional payment. Under-age alcohol control measures will be provided to each Head of Delegation.

Extra tickets will be available at the OC office at 45€ per person. Requests for extra tickets must be made, at the very latest, by Sunday morning (March 12<sup>th</sup>).

# 20. Covid'19 regulations

"As of July 1, 2022, passengers entering national territory (including Azores and Madeira) are no longer required to present proof of carrying out a test to screen for SARS-CoV-2 infection with a negative result or to present a COVID-EU digital certificate or vaccination or recovery certificate issued by third countries, accepted or recognized in Portugal."
