General Regulations:

The New Star 2025 competition will be held for young and beginner skaters. The New Star 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and all respective ISU Communications for figure skating and the technical requirements of the Estonian Skating Union for the season 2025/2026.

Participation in the New Star 2024 is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and its member Clubs, and qualify for eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a). They meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation or its Member Clubs. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (fully or partially).

The results will be calculated according to ISU judges system.

The competition will be held in the following categories and classes:

Single Skating A class:

Pre-Chicks and younger (Estonian technical requirements for season 2025/2026);

Chicks (Estonian technical requirements for season 2025/2026);

Cubs (Estonian technical requirements for season 2025/2026);

Basic Novice (According to latest ISU rules and communications);

Intermediate Novice (According to latest ISU rules and communications);

Advanced Novice (In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2699 and any subsequent updates.);

Junior (ISU Technical Rules Single&Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611 paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/26, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication)

Senior (ISU Technical Rules Single&Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, 612, According to latest ISU rules and communications)

Single Skating B class:

Pre-Chicks 2019 and younger; Chicks 2017/2018; Cubs 2015/2016; Springs, Novice B, Junior B; Estonian technical requirements for season 2025/2026

Amateur Skating:

Pre-Young 2015 and younger; Pre-Young 2013/2014; Young 2011/2012; Young 2005-2010; Estonian technical requirements for season 2025/2026

Adults:

Ladies, Men: Bronze, Silver, Gold, Master

Free Skating

Artistic Skating

The Organizers have the right to split and combine categories if the number of participants requires that.

Registration of entries for New Star 2025

All ISU-Members and all Clubs, National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to the competition in any category and class. However, the Organizer shall have the right to limit the number of skaters from the invited clubs, and split categories if the number of participants requires that.

The deadline for entries is **29. September 2025**. All entries to the New Star 2025 must be submitted using the Sportity Online Registration system: <https://fs.sportity.com/>. The clubs, that don't have an account should contact Sportity by email: info@sportity.com and inquire about registration by providing the following information: Name of Organization, Reg.code, Country, contact e-mail address.

The deadline for entries is September 29th, 2025 23:59 local time.

Entry fee before and on 29th September 2025:

Single skaters with one program —85€ per person

Single skaters with two programs — 100€ per person

Late entry fee after 29th September 2025 and before 6th October 2025:

Single skaters with one program —95€ per person

Single skaters with two programs —110€ per person

Deadline for payment is **6. October 2025**.

The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment and from that moment can only be substituted by another skater if an emergency cancellation occurs. The OC reserves the right to cancel the Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline. Any changes in entry form has to be made at least 24 hours before drawing. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries. Payment must be made to:

Draw:

An electronic draw will take place on **October 22th 2025**. Starting orders will be published on competition website: <http://newstar.juna.ee/>

Mandate:

All participating clubs are asked to send their final entry forms for the draw by **October 21th 2025, 12 p.m.**

Music:

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, the name of the category, the segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

Example:

EST_Chicks_Boys_FS_Smith_John.mp3

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note:

Files in MP3 format may significantly differ in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality is insufficient.

- each Competitor must have its own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- the exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- each music must be submitted to the **Sportity Online Registration System** (<https://fs.sportity.com/>) by latest **October 13th 2025**.

Insurance and Liability:

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The OC assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

The code of ethics:

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU com. 2478. Action against this rule conducts behind itself the disqualification of skater.

Time schedule:

Preliminary time schedule will be available on our website: www.juna.ee one week before competition.

Awarding:

The three best-placed competitors in each event will be awarded with a trophy or medal. All competitors will receive a diploma.

Expences:

All participants and teams must pay the accommodation and transportation themselves.

Protests:

Each team has the right to submit protest against the judge's decision. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event at the latest immediately after the event. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. In the new ISU Judging Systems no protests can be filed against the judges (see Rule 123), but against the right determination of the executed element or any calculation error. In the ISU Judging System protest can be submitted in 24 hours after subsegment (e.g. Short Program) and before the awarding ceremony after the final segment (e.g. Free Skating). Protest must be done in a written form to the referee of the relevant segment. Please read ISU Rule 123.
