The role provides experience in paediatric drug and device development through exposure to industry, academic and regulatory perspectives on the design, conduct and policy of paediatric clinical trials.

About EFGCP

EFGCP is a non-profit organisation established by and for professionals involved in developing medicines and medical devices for patients. It is a leading European multi-stakeholder forum where science, quality and ethics meet to promote Good Clinical Practice in clinical research and development.

About the CMWP

The EFGCP's [Children's Medicines Working Party \(CMWP\)](#) promotes the highest scientific, ethical, safety, and quality standards for the design, conduct, and analysis of biomedical research and medicines development for children of all ages. The CMWP meets remotely once a month for 1.5 hours, and members are expected to contribute to a number of EFGCP projects.

Terms of reference:

- Appointment is open to paediatric residents/registrars within a recognised national paediatric training rotation in Europe.
- Appointment is limited to trainees who have completed at least one full year of paediatric training and have at least two years of training remaining.
- Duration of appointment: 2 years.
- Remuneration: None.
- Waiver of EFGCP annual membership fees for the duration of the appointment.
- Offer of a slot for presentation at the annual paediatric EFGCP conference with waiver of attendance fees.

Desirable but not essential criteria for appointment:

- Affiliation with a paediatric society.
- Qualification in, or research experience related to, drug development.
